1. What is a pilot course and its It's a test course for trying out the learning material that has been developed at your institution purpose? applying Hybrid training methodology. A pilot course can be started when: the training **content** has been developed (see Technical specification for course development HYBVET); a person in charge is appointed at the educational institution (administrator for the application of the hybrid methodology) who will coordinate all activities related to training; the hybrid training **administration procedure** has been prepared (student attendance schedule, duration of training, responsibilities, functions, etc.); 2. When can we start piloting? hybrid training place has been arranged (separate room with high-speed internet connection, tablets / phones, equipment needed according to training topics, etc.); lists of students and teachers / evaluators have been formed, the roles have been assigned in the extLMS system: the teachers who will evaluate the students have completed the training course themselves and are able to independently evaluate the participants in the system. Participants of the pilot course include: an administrator; 3. Who and how many persons can a leader: participate in the pilot course? teachers / evaluators (4 persons as indicated in the application); participants / students (minimum 15 at each partner institution). The duration of the pilot course is determined by the institution itself, but it must last long enough for 4. According to the project, a minimum of 15 people must be trained, who are divided into 5 groups of 3 participants each (leader, evaluator, assistant). What has to be done by a student - solve course topic tests (if applicable); before the pilot course starts? - send the latest version of the "HybridLab" application to the tablet / phone (if one has to use the devices during the training). The pilot course is completed when: - all course participants / students solved all control situations of the course; 9. When is the pilot course - all course participants / students filled out the course evaluation questionnaire; completed? - all lecturers / evaluators evaluated all control situations of the course and sent their evaluation from the system to the course participants / students.
